

REGISTRATION (PASSPORT) INFORMATION

PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION BEFORE YOU COMPLETE THE FORM

To be used for ALL applications / sections

A HORSE CAN ONLY BE ISSUED WITH ONE PASSPORT

PLEASE ENSURE YOU ARE FAMILIAR WITH THE CHANGES IN PASSPORT LAW SINCE JANUARY 2016

It is a legal requirement that all horses must have a passport and that they have been microchipped if born in 2009 onwards. You can be fined £5000 if you cannot present a passport when requested to do so.

AQHA-UK register and issue passports for section I / II / III and X of the quarter horse register and section V for identification purposes only. The five sections include:

Section I - Purebred Quarter horses that have an AQHA Certificate of Registration.

Appendix - Quarter Horse / TB that has an AQHA Appendix Certificate.

Section II - Horses that are more than 50% Quarter Horse that can be proven through parentage paperwork.

Section III – Horses with one parent who is a full Quarter Horse that can be proven through parentage.

Section V - Non of the above where a passport is required for identification only.

APPLICATION FORM - MUST DO's

- ★ **NEW** - The marking and diagram sheet **MUST** be completed by the VET and signed and stamped
- ★ **NEW** - You **MUST** complete the **BREEDERS CERTIFICATE** and the **STALLION OWNERS CERTIFICATE** and **this must be signed!** If born outside of the UK complete all but the signature
- ★ The microchip bar code must attached to the top of the sheet
- ★ You **MUST** only use the AQHA-UK form. Any other is not acceptable in our passport system
- ★ All sections to be completed with the exception of the extended pedigree where a Certificate of Registration is supplied
- ★ It is mandatory that you indicate whether or not the horse has had a Genetic Disease 5 Panel test for HYPP, PSSM, MH, GBED and HERDA and provide these results so that they can be entered into the passport. You can also supply other results for inclusion should you wish. As a Breed Association we promote good breeding practices and recommend that all horses undergo genetic testing and that these results and entered onto the UK database.
- ★ For ALL SECTION I purebred registrations you **MUST** send a **COPY** of the AQHA USA Certificate of Registration in the name of the owner

- ★ Appendix sections should send a copy of the AQHA Appendix certificate
- ★ Sections II & III should send a copy of the parents Certificate of Registration. If this is not available check with the passport office to see if we have a copy

Any forms not completed correctly or where will be returned. Passports will only be issued on receipt of payment.

PLEASE ALLOW 21 DAYS FOR YOUR PASSPORT TO BE CREATED.

Dont' leave it until the last minute to apply for a passport. If you do not apply for a passport before the foal is 6 months old or before 31st December in the year of birth the passport is issued as a duplicate and has this watermarked into the passport.

THERE IS A £20 SURCHARGE FOR PASSPORT APPLICATIONS RECIEVED IN DECEMBER.

The passport office will be closed from 18th December until 3rd January 2017

HOW TO PAY

Our preferred method of payment is by BACS as this is the most economical way of administering payments although we do accept PayPal and Cheques. We cannot take card payments.

BACS - BACS transfer details are: AQHA-UK, sort code - 20-49-08 Acc No. 00566209. In the reference box add ' MREG' for current members and 'NMREG' for non members. If you are paying from a business account please add the surname of the horse owner.
