

## ***Pre-show clinic with Lucy Adams***

Our AQHA International Judge, Lucy Adams, will hold a clinic at SNEC on Saturday 25 June 2022. This gives those attending an opportunity to work with the judge BEFORE the show to gain an insight into what the standard is for the various classes and what the judge will be looking for on show day. The holding of a judge led pre-show clinic has been sanctioned by AQHA in order to encourage members and non-members alike to take part in Western riding and gain a greater understanding of the art of showing your horse in competition. AQHA-UK are grateful to AQHA for this relaxation of their rules to allow the clinic to be led by the judge and for their continued support and commitment to all of us in Scotland in helping to promote both the Quarter Horse breed and the American Quarter Horse Association.

Entries to the clinic are strictly limited and places will be allocated on a first come (and fully paid), first served (and booked) basis. If the clinic is over-subscribed a waiting list will be formed, again based on a first come, first served basis. Unfortunately, no refund of the clinic fee is available for cancellation of entry unless the place can be taken by an individual on the waiting list or, in the event of there being no persons remaining on the waiting list, by a substitute identified by the person withdrawing.

The entry fee for the clinic is £80 and must accompany the clinic entry form.

All riders and competitors who are not AQHA-UK members will be required to pay a weekend membership fee of £10, this will cover the pre-show clinic and the show, for those doing both. If a competitor subsequently joins AQHA-UK within 2 months as a member they will receive a £10 discount on their membership fee. Please note that only fully paid up members of AQHA-UK will be eligible for the AQHA-UK Youth and Amateur Hi Point Awards at the show.

Stabling is available at SNEC and must be booked directly with SNEC either online or by emailing [stables@sneec.co.uk](mailto:stables@sneec.co.uk)

Charges are £30 for 1 night, £50 for 2 nights or £15 for a day stables. There are 15 stables adjacent to the car park and a further 12 stables at the nearby farm. Overnight stables have 1 bale of shavings provided and day stables have a ½ bale provided. Extra shavings can be purchased at £7 per bale. NO hay or haylage is available. Extra shavings should be purchased in advance. Stables are provided on a self muck out basis and SNEC will levy an additional charge for stables that are not mucked out.

There are 6 electric hook ups available at £15 per night. These must also be booked with SNEC online or at [stables@sneec.co.uk](mailto:stables@sneec.co.uk)

Please note that in order to comply with current UK legislation on Equine Passports you must have your horses passport at the clinic (and show if competing) Passports should be up to date with the current owner shown on the passport. These will be checked. All horses vaccinations must be up to date. You should also ensure that your personal horse insurance is up to date as regards your own third party liabilities.
